MEMBERSHIP 2025-26

(FOR CURRENT FULL-TIME UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS)

Round I

1. Membership of residential halls/Residential Colleges in Jockey Club Student Village III/Jockey Club Student Village IV(Wong Chuk Hang) is entirely voluntary. Current students may apply for all types of accommodation at the same time but a student can only accept one type of accommodation.
2. Round I (Application period: April 10 – 17, 2025)

The following current students may apply in Round I:

- (1) Current residents in residential halls for the academic year 2024-25 seeking re-admission to the same hall; or
- (2) Current residents in residential halls for the academic year 2024-25 seeking admission to another hall; or
- (3) Students returning from exchange who had been residing in a residential hall immediately prior to exchange; or
- (4) Current residents who intend to proceed immediately to study in 2025-26 for the MArch, PCLL, or a second undergraduate degree under the "double-degree" curricula

NB:

Residential halls: Applications from current students other than those in the four categories mentioned above will **NOT** be processed in Round I.

Residential Colleges in Jockey Club Student Village III and Jockey Club Student Village IV (Wong Chuk Hang): Current residents who wish to re-apply for the Residential Colleges or apply for residential halls should submit application in Round I.

Round II (Application period: August 8 – 14, 2025)

The following students shall apply in Round II:

- (1) Current students who have no prior hall experience in 2024-25; or
- (2) Students who are newly admitted into a study programme in 2025-26

3. 2025-26 Round I applications via the on-line hall application system are now invited. The system is accessible via HKU Portal (<https://hkuportal.hku.hk>) and will be opened to current full-time undergraduate and postgraduate students from **10:00 a.m. on April 10, 2025** and will be closed at **5:59 p.m. on April 17, 2025**. You are strongly advised to submit your application as early as possible during the application period in order to avoid a major system overload near the application deadline which may lead to delay or even rejection of your application. Please note that late applications will *not* be considered.
4. Applicants are advised to read carefully the General Information and Instructions (at <http://ase.hku.hk/>) before proceeding to fill in the application form. You should take particular note of the interview arrangements and the dates when application results will be announced.
5. Residential halls, Residential Colleges in Jockey Club Student Village III and Jockey Club Student Village IV (Wong Chuk Hang)

After the announcement of results on May 26, 2025, an applicant who is offered a place must indicate acceptance of the offer through the on-line system of the HKU Portal (<https://hkuportal.hku.hk>) → Login HKU Portal → select “SIS Menu” → select “On-line application” → select “Application for Resident Hall” → select “Application Status” by 5:00 p.m. on June 2, 2025. Otherwise, the offer will be automatically withdrawn.

6. Starting from 2019-20, a web-based system has been in use to generate the distance scores for travelling time from students' homes (based on the home address records in the Portal) to the Main Campus for individual applicants. You are highly recommended to double check the correctness of your home address records in the Portal **before 6:00 pm on April 8, 2025 (Tuesday)** to ensure that the system can find the correct distance scores for you.
